After an invasion of unwanted weeds in 2022 the City delacared enough is enough.

City forces will agresivally attack weeds on city right-of-ways. Their means of attack will be by using mechanical, chemical, and thermal weapons! These means are also know as mowing, herbicide, and fire.

Residents are encouraged to keep weeds under control on their own property.

Residents who wish to avoid the city spraying near their property should keep weeds in check, liminating the need for the city to "get too close."

WATER SCHEDULE

Now that spring has finally arrived, it is important to remember the watering schedule.

- Odd numbered addresses may water Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Even numbered addresses may water Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

No watering between 10:00 A.M. & 6:00 P.M.

This schedule, that is in ordinance, is designed to help keep our water system run effectively and efficiently, as well as protect our water rights in drought years.



LITTER AND DUMPING...

The City of Roberts has made a large dumpster available to City residents for their big and bulky trash items.

This service is offered to help keep our city clean and as a convienence to our rate payers!

The big dumpster has been abused often, both by residents and non-residents alike.

Here is the scoop...

Only Roberts city residents are allowed to use the big dumpster, as they are who pays for it through sanitation fees.

Non-city residents who use it, are guilty of a misdemeanor for theft of services.

Any one using the dumpster must put items **IN THE DUMPSTER!**

Leaving trash on the ground is in violation of the cities nusience ordinance and is a misdemeanor.

Littering is rude and against the law.

If you have bulky items you are unable to get in the dumpster call City Hall to make an appointment to get assistance.

Tires, refrigerators, freezers, air conditionors, oil, chemicals, and hazerdous waste are strictly forbidden!

Sherriffs deputies have issued several warnings for violators and citations will be issued, if needed.

Do you have a full trash tote every week? Call City Hall to arrange for another can for your house.

Jefferson county operates 2 landfills. Call the County for hours and regulations.

JUNK CARS...

A junk car sweep will take effect soon.

Cars, trailers, and campers parked on city right-of-way are required by Law to be liscenced. Vehichles on city right-of-way in violation of the ordinance may be cited and or towed at the owners expence.

There is a 72 hour time limit for parking in city rights of way.

Parking in alleys is not allowed.
